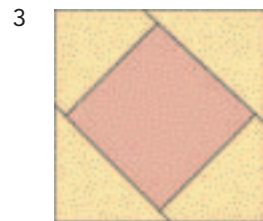
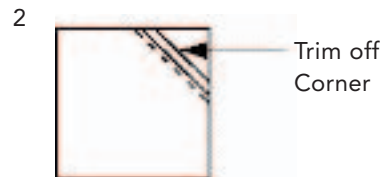
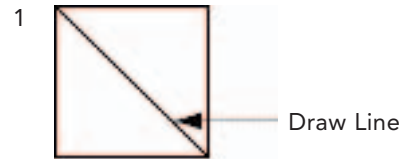

BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

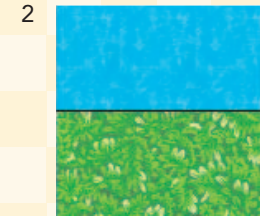
Square in a Square:

- Using a #2 pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of four 2-in. (5.08cm) yellow-print squares as shown.
- Position one 2-in. (5.08cm) yellow-print square on one corner of a 3½-in. (8.89cm) pink-print square, right sides together. Stitch on the marked line, and trim off the corner leaving a ¼-in. (0.64cm) seam allowance. Iron the triangle outward.
- Repeat step 2 to stitch one yellow-print square to the corner opposite the corner sewn in step 2. Trim and iron the corner outward. Stitch the other two yellow-print squares to the remaining corners. Trim and iron the corners outward.
- Repeat 35 times for a total of 36 pink-and-yellow-print “square-in-a-square” units.



Strip Sets:

- Sew a 2-in.-wide (5.08cm) blue-print strip and a 2-in.-wide (5.08cm) green-print strip together. Iron.
- Cut the strip into six 6½-in. (16.51cm) strip-set segments.
- Repeat with the remaining five 2-in.-wide (5.08cm) blue-print strips and five green-print strips. From the strip sets, cut 30 6½-in.-wide (16.51cm) strip-set segments, for a total of 36 segments.



Block Construction:

- Sew a pink-and-yellow-print “square in a square” to each end of a blue-and-green-print strip-set segment as shown. Iron. Repeat.



- Sew a blue-and-green-print strip-set segment to each side of a 6½-in. (16.51cm) focus fabric square. Iron.



- Assemble the block as shown. Iron.
Repeat to make a total of nine blocks.
